RE: CLOGHANELINAGHAN SECTION OF THE SOUTH KERRY GREENWAY

SCHEME PARTICULARS

The Cloghanelinaghan Section of the South Kerry Greenway involves the construction of 1.3km of greenway and associated site works with approx. 1km of the route running parallel to the south of the L7528.

The proposed greenway travels in a northeasterly direction from its starting point, approx. 600m northeast of the Valentia Estuary Viaduct. The alignment begins by running northwest along a field boundary for approx. 250m, before turning northeast and continuing parallel to the south of the L7528 for approx. 1,050m. The alignment will run parallel to the south of the L7528 and will be located behind the existing hedgerow within the adjacent fields. The greenway will provide a safe route independently segregated from the public road (L7528) for both pedestrians and cyclists and will connect into the South Kerry Greenway to the west and east.

The proposed works will consist of:

- removal of the topsoil, where greenfield.
 - construction of a 3m wide paved surface (asphalt concrete) with a 1m wide grass verge on each side of the paved surface.
 - retaining existing hedgerows, where present, to be left in-situ and repaired as required.
 - stock proofing fence, where required.
 - boundary fencing or treatments, as agreed.
 - signage, road markings and traffic calming measures.
 - pedestrian / cycle and agricultural crossing points and gates, where required.
 - retaining and making good the existing drainage.
 - new drainage, as over the edge to drainage channels or filter drains, as necessary, and to existing drainage outlets.
 - additional landscaping / screening, where required all other associated site works.
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
