Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1994, as amended by the Public Transportation Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), Kerry County Council proposes a streetscape enhancement project in Ballybunion.

The proposed works will involve:

- Proposed raised table and zebra crossings with associated signing and lining at the Sandhill/Strand Road junction.
- Proposed Zebra crossings with associated signing and lining on existing raised table at Main Street/Cliff Road Junction.
- Proposed Zebra crossings with associated signing and lining on existing raised table at Main Street/SuperValu carpark junction.
