
Annex A: Actions

As noted, the LACAP sets out how Kerry County Council will be responsible for enhancing climate resilience, increasing energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions, across its own assets, services and infrastructure, for which it has full accountability. KCC however will also need to proactively use its broader role of influencing, co-ordinating/facilitating and advocating other sectors, to meet their own climate targets and ambitions – as envisaged in the graphic below.



The function of this annex is to provide a list of actions (specific, measurable action-focused, realistic and timebound) under each of the 5 strategic goals outlining how *accountability*; *influencing*; *co-ordination/facilitation* and *advocation* will be achieved to meet climate action targets. For clarity a simple colour code is used for the actions:
